

Nu-4-U Clothing Information

The Nu-4-U clothing activity was established for two reasons. First, to offer residents a convenient opportunity to dispose of their unused clothing for further use by donating it to a good cause, and second, to raise funds for the Brittany Pointe Estates Residents Association. The Nu-4-U committee encourages the donation of new and gently used clothing throughout the year. The donated clothing is then made available to residents via sales held at various times of the year, with the biggest sale occurring at the Annual Bazaar.

There is a Nu-4-U representative in each Brittany Pointe Independent Living building (Aspen, Birch and Chestnut) and they willingly accept donations. Upon receipt, the items are placed in a holding room. Committee meetings are held once a week to go over the clothes received. They are sorted, priced, made ready for sale, and then placed in their proper racks. Many hands make light work, and anyone who would like to be a part of this committee is most welcome.
