

Party Bridge Information

This bridge game is the oldest continuous game still active at Brittany Pointe.

Beginning about 1996, it has been a a source of enjoyment for many bridge players through the years. This is the place for new residents to play bridge. We meet every Tuesday evening in the Card Room, down the hall from the more publicized Shear Delights Hair Salon.

We begin by (or before) 6:45 p.m. We must have players present in multiples of four (no sit-outs or by-stands). Entry fee is \$0.50 each, with cash prizes dependent on the number of tables (example - 4 tables – 1st Place wins \$4.00, lesser amounts for 2nd and 3rd places). There is always a booby prize of \$0.50. The first three place's names are publicized; the booby prize winner stays unknown.

The group plays four rounds of four hands each; winning pair goes to another table with a new partner and new opponents. This is done four times, for a total of 16 Hands.

The scoring is duplicate scoring, so no honors are counted. It is not rubber bridge scoring! After four rounds the totals are compared and winners awarded their prizes.

Usually the game is over before 9:00 p.m. It is important to arrive as early as possible, since anyone arriving after the last four-player group is formed will go home.

It is also important to be prepared for any temperature in the Card Room since the HVAC system is not user-friendly.
