RE: RESIDENT PARKING

During last weeks' Let's Talk meeting we had a lively discussion on the subject of resident parking. We thought it would be appropriate to review a few "house rules". Resident self-management of these is expected.

Second cars: Residents with two cars are permitted to park one car near their apartment and the second car in lot A or a remote space in either D or F lots.

Resident only lots (B,C,E and G): Friends and family members' vehicles should not be parked in our resident only lots. While it is customary for residents to use the same parking spaces there are no assigned spaces or lots for residents.

Handicapped spaces: It is the expectation that those parking in these spaces have official designation (handicapped license plate or hang tag) for use of this space and that it be displayed prominently.
