### Application for the Ambassador for Peace Medal awarded by the Republic of Korea

Eligibility Requirements: An eligible veteran must have served in Korea at some time during the Korean War from June 25, 1950 to July 27, 1953. Members of the US Navy are eligible if they served aboard a naval vessel that was assigned to Korean waters during the aforementioned timeframe. Veterans who participated in UN peacekeeping efforts in Korea until the end of 1955 are also eligible for this award. To apply, please contact Mr. Ramos below:
