

Duplicate Bridge Information

Duplicate Bridge at Brittany Pointe Estates is scheduled every Wednesday at 12:30 p.m. in the Card Room. Come with your favorite partner* and enjoy bridge with the element of luck reduced.

The game is played with hands shuffled and placed in boards, so that the same hands may be played by everybody. Players sitting North/South remain stationary at their tables; players sitting East/West move up to the next table after playing three or four boards, while the boards move down to the next table. In this way all the E/W pairs get to play all the hands, and against all the N/S pairs.

The results of each engagement are recorded, and at the end of the game a comparative score is calculated, so that you and your partner can see how well you did on each hand compared to how the other pairs playing in your direction did.

Bidding boxes are used so that all bidding sequences are in full view until a contract is reached. However, if you feel uncomfortable using the boxes, you may ignore them and simply bid as usual, announcing your bids verbally.

The results are posted in the Card Room, and also emailed to participants who so desire. These show the rankings, and the results on each hand, which you may review with your partner to improve your game.
