

Resident Bible Study Information

The Resident Bible Study small groups started in 2018 with three groups studying the Gospel of John. It took all year, but we got through all 31 chapters. We are divided into three groups to keep our numbers small, which is better for discussion, and provides the opportunity for residents to choose the time/day that work best for them. The groups are led by Bonnie Hurd, Jeanne Myers, and Jean Nungesser. Starting in January of 2021 we will offer two groups; one will meet on Mondays at 2:00 p.m. and the second will meet on Thursdays at 10:00 a.m. Both groups meet in the Executive Conference Room.

In November of 2020 we finished studying the Book of Acts which we had started in 2019, but had to put on hold because of the pandemic. In January of 2021 we will start a study of a very important Biblical topic, the death and resurrection of Jesus and what that means for us today.

In each session we read a portion of scripture, usually a chapter. We look at the historical context as well as compare it to other scriptures. We finish with discussing what impact that scripture should have on us today.
